This internship offers a unique opportunity for emerging scholars to expand their academic horizons and is conducted on a voluntary basis. At the end of your internship, we will offer you:

- A certificate of your training and your practicum as interns (up to the WAU conference in November 2024)
- A waiver for online registration for the 2024 South Africa WAU Congress

The call for interns will be open until January 25, 2024. The training of selected candidates will take place in February 2024.
